Area XI Student Nominating Committee

Selection Process

Being an Area XI FFA Association Officer Nominating Committee member is very important. You will play a vital role in the area officer election process. Your decisions will directly affect the success of the officer team and area events. Good luck!

The Nominating Committee will consist of a total of 9 people, 1 FFA member from each district, one teacher elected from each District and the State Officer from Area XI serving as chair (non scoring member). In the event the state officer is unavailable the Area President will serve as the chair.

Qualifications:

- Area officers may not apply to be on the Student Nominating Committee.
- If you serve on the Student Nominating Committee, you cannot run for Area office.
- Nominating committee must meet the following criteria
 - 1. Be juniors or seniors in high school for the current school year.
 - 2. Complete each page of this application.

3. Application must be completed and submitted to the Area XI Association Election Committee Superintendent by April 1st.

4. Application must be submitted by the applicant's advisor. By the advisor emailing the application, he/she is certifying that the information contained in the application is correct and that he/she agrees to the terms on the check sheet.

Applications will be evaluated by the following criteria:

- Current Area officers will review and rank all applications by district.
- Area Election Committee will review and rank all applications by district
- The top two applicants from combined rankings (from Area officers and Area Election Committee) from each district will meet on Zoom with the Area President, Area 1st Vice President and Area Election Superintendent for an informal interview and informational meeting about the process.

Area Student Nominating Committee Selections will be announced by May 1st.

All Student Nominating Committee members need to be available for Phase 1 and Phase 2 of the Area Election process, please see the Area XI Election Schedule for more information.
